April Meeting

The meeting featured an informative presentation by **Gallo Toapanta** of the Southwest Carpenters Training Fund. He described the many training programs offered by the Carpenters Union, including classroom instruction with handson training for both apprentices and journeymen. Training centers offer a range of classes, including concrete forms, interior systems, framing, solid surface, door hardware, forklift operation, scaffold erection, blueprint reading, layout, welding, cleanroom, solar and more. Earlier that morning, a group of WOW members toured the Carpenters Union Training Center in Buena Park. That training center has been supplying WOW with lumber for the club's toy projects. Their donation of lumber is much appreciated.

Nethercutt Collection Tour

Woodworker of the Year

Forms to nominate a club member for Woodworker of the Year honors will be available at the April and May meetings. Forms must be completed and submitted to President Alan Schwartz by the end of the May meeting. The guidelines for this award are as follows:

Description

Each year, the Woodworkers of Whittier shall have the option of honoring one of its members as Woodworker of the Year. The period will be from July 1 of the present year to June 30 of the following June.

Criteria

The Woodworker of the Year honoree shall be a member in good standing. He or she shall have been active in club events, and have participated in club activities, such as attending meetings, participating in toy-making projects, participating in community outreach events, staging woodworking demonstrations, serving as an officer, serving on committees, helping to organize events, etc. He or she should also be an active woodworker. This award is not necessarily for the most skilled worker in the club, but honors the one who has made outstanding contributions of service to further the goals for the club.

Nominations

Nominations for Woodworker of the Year may be made by any member. Nominations shall be submitted to the club president on a nomination form to be provided at one or more regular club meetings.

Selection

Selection shall be made at the May Steering Committee meeting. All members in good standing attending the meeting may express opinions on various nominees. After discussion is concluded, those attending the meeting shall make a selection by secret ballot. In the event of a tie, the president shall make the final decision. In the event that one of the members present has been nominated, that member shall leave the room during the discussion of that member's nomination. If agreed upon by members, the club may decide not to name a winner for that year. The club may also decide to name co-winners, if appropriate.

Timing

Nomination forms will be available at the April and May club meetings. Completed forms are to be returned to the president. The winner will be selected at the May Steering Committee meeting and announced at the regular June club meeting. The award will be presented at the July club meeting. This will allow time for any plaques to be made, etc.
