STEERING COMMITTEE ACTIONS

The report of the Program Committee was accepted and approved.

John Rodgers led a discussion of the BSA event on Saturday, May 22. The scouts will provide 2 tables, 2 chairs and 1 canopy for a display of **WOW** toy projects and asked that 1 or 2 other members accompany him. **Jim Lockwood** and **Mike Scott** volunteered to help. **Ron Holtz** will make the **WOW** sign available.

Ron Holtz reported Cerritos College was having a woodworker event on campus the same day as the BSA event and he intended to attend.

An extensive discussion of **WOW**'s participation in the Cub Scouts Day Camp, presented by the day camp staff at the Club's May 13th. meeting. The discussion was centered on what kind of kit, how many kits, would the club provide funding if necessary?

The kits would be simple; tool box, step stool, seat, bird house, and letter box were all deemed appropriate. The total number of kits is 125. They do not have to be identical from group to group, but each group of ten is identical. The kits are to be assembled with nails instead of screws and nail locations will be predrilled. Kits will not be sanded. The Steering Committee voted to spend money for the wood as needed.

John Rodgers will co-ordinate with the scouts and club members. John met with Steve Ceballos, Camp Director at the Saturday function. The day camp staff will furnish the hammers, nails, and sandpaper to complete the projects.
