As in the past potlucks we will have two raffles. The first is for members only and will be a complete set of woodworking books.

The second raffle is for our members and invited guests. Our guests include those persons who provide **wood** for blocks and cars, **space** for block production, **dolls** for cradles and the **block painters**. Each is special to us, the Woodworkers Of Whittier.

All Members are encouraged to bring three shop made door prizes for the second raffle. We hope to have a prize for all guests, spouses and members. Members are encouraged to bring their spouse or friend.

The December meeting is our annual Christmas Pot Luck. This is a potluck party. **Each member** is requested to bring a **main dish or salad or dessert** and **serving utensils to serve 10 to 12 people.** Food should be cut

Bagging Day
