TOY FINISHING

We discussed regulatory changes of finishes and materials as they pertain to **ALL** for all toys for **ANY CHILD** including your children and grandchildren. We are personally responsible for any toy for any child. At present the regulations address finishes only. Finishes of any type must be certified lead free by an independent laboratory.

New regulations will be in effect for the 2011 Christmas Season requiring lead free certification for all materials used in toys except natural wood. Glue, nails, screws, brads and tacks are just some of the materials that will be tested and certified.

This certification will be made available to toymakers by a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS). All vendors must make a copy of everything they sell to any buyer that requests it. This system has been available for some years and new MSDS will be updated as materials are tested and certified.

JOE CARRILLO

Joe Carrillo announced that this is his last year of supervising the block painting, as age 90 is approaching. **Joe** has supervised the painting of thousands and thousands of building blocks for the past 15 years. He said that over the course of more than 700 sessions he has missed only 3. **Joe** said he would continue to work at Hathaway Ranch in the cutting and sanding production of the building blocks.

Securing a replacement will be a function of the steering committee and the **Woodworkers Of Whittier**. When you see Joe, shake his hand and say “Thanks for a magnificent job.” He does deserve it!
